

Potting Soil Mixes

Cornell's Peat-Lite Mix A:

Ingredients: 4 quarts	#2 size vermiculite
4 quarts	shredded sphagnum peat moss
1 level Tablespoon	agricultural limestone
1 level Tablespoon	20% superphosphate
2 level Tablespoons	potassium nitrate (use only 1
Tablespoon for starting seeds.)	

Wet & mix thoroughly before potting.

Soiless Seed Starting Mix:

- 1 part perlite
- 1 part vermiculite
- 1 part peat moss or potting soil

Greenhouse Soil Mix:

- 2 parts of potting soil
- 1 part of leaf mold or compost
- 1 part peat moss
- 1 part clean sand or perlite
- 1 Tablespoon superphosphate
- 2 Tablespoons of lime
- 4 Tablespoons of dried cow manure

Cornell Seed Starting Mix – 1 Peck:

- 4 quarts of #2 grade horticulture vermiculite
- 4 quarts of shredded peat moss
- 1 Tablespoon 20% powdered superphosphate
- 2 Tablespoons of ground limestone
- 1 ½ Tablespoons of 33% ammonium nitrate or 4 Tablespoons of 5-10-5 fertilizer
